The following activities are available:

1. Reptile Park (9 USD Entry fee)

Walk around the park to see the different reptiles. Encounters with some of the snakes can be arranged at the park.

2. Elephant Sanctuary and interact with animals (66 USD pp)

This elephant Sanctuary is a haven and halfway house for the African Elephant. Enjoy the interactivity between elephant and human.

3. Cable car up the mountain for a spectacular view (16 USD pp)

Swiss engineered and installed cableway is a family-friendly fun and adventure for young and old alike at the top of the Magaliesberg with a breath-taking view of the area.

4. Take Scootours and ride through nature (25 USD PP self-drive, and 10USD for Passengers)

Enjoy scenic safari style self-drive through nature on one of their non-motorised scooters and see majestic views of Cradle of Humankind.

5. Chameleon village and shop local arts and crafts market (free)

Scroll through the village and feast your eye on all the local art and crafts as well as eats.

6. Cradle of Humankind

Fascinating exploration of Africa tribal history entwined with sumptuous hospitality situated in the Cradle of Humankind in proximity of the dam.

7. Ann Van Dyk Cheetah Centre (24 USD PP)

Established as far back as 1971 as a tribute to Ann van Dyk who devote her life on the survival of the cheetah and other endangered species.

8. Upside-down House (5 USD pp)

Exactly what it says, enjoy the fun in on the upside-down house. This is what the mind cannot comprehend.

9. Van Gaalen cheese factory and restaurant (8 USD PP)

Enjoy this gem and see the art of cheese making and enjoy the restaurant. The farm boasts with a magnificent play area for kids, hiking trails, picnic spots and more!

10. Selfie House and restaurant (8 USD PP)

A marvellous house transformed in a photo opportunity of your dreams, from big and bold designs to funny and artisic rooms, this is certainly an experience that you do not want to miss out on.
